THE BOARD OF APPEALS VOTED:

To grant a Special Permit with conditions for two family use and grant exception to minimum lot area of 45,000 sq. ft. to 13,937 sq. ft. and minimum lot frontage of 200 feet to approximately 180 feet, to allow conversion of the former Montague Center Fire Station to a two family dwelling.

Conditions:

1. The paved area of the lot shall be significantly reduced. All pavement areas shall be removed from the rear and right (east side) of the lot and reduced on the left (west) side in substantial conformance with the site plan dated May 11, 2005.
2. The public sidewalk shall be delineated across the full driveway width by a row of pavers saw cut into the existing pavement or by other contrasting material acceptable to the Highway Department and Board of Appeals.
3. All commercial/industrial or high intensity lighting shall be removed.
