Appeal the Inspector of Buildings decision that an apartment to store front conversion cannot be reversed; *or to grant relief by Special Permit* for the reinstatment of a non-conforming use and structure (pursuant to Section 5.1.4); *or allow* a mixed Craft Workshop/ residential unit pursuant to section 5.2.11(b) of the Montague Zoning Bylaws.

#### The Board of Appeals finds:

- The previous owner converted the first floor apartment of 100/102 Third Street to a retail craft workshop.
- Applicant stated that upon purchase of the property a shop usage was contemplated, but personal circumstances have changed to where exclusive residential use is needed.
- The building is located where commercial street level use transitions to nonconforming residential use.
- The Board concludes the Appeal of the reversibility of a street level commercial use need not be decided to resolve this case.

#### THE BOARD OF APPEALS VOTED:

*Not to grant a Special Permit* to reinstate the use of the first floor of 100 Third Street as a residential unit.

*Not to grant the Appeal* meant to allow the mixing of craft/workshop with a residential use in a commercial unit.
