The Director is responsible for managing and operating these three libraries, administering a budget of approximately \$400,000 and serving a community of 8,300 people. Working closely with the Board of Library Trustees and town administration, the Director oversees and monitors all library operations, including service delivery, personnel management, budgeting, strategic planning, and facilities management.

The Search Committee rotated asking interview questions. After the interview, the Committee discussed their impressions of the candidate.
