• Carnegie a/c: DPW is taking on the project. They'll repair rather than replace; not time to put out to bid.

- CK: everything now in the application platform, ready to hit Submit.
- TP: glad we hired Barbara, worth the expenditure. CK: she billed us less than the total allotment.
- WQ: read an excerpt from the town's 200th anniversary book (1954) re: Carnegie lib, including: "the building was not erected until there had been the customary argumentation and debate that is part of every building program."

• Met, talked about process of employee annual reviews. Staff fairly intimidated/anxious about them. Looking at how to make process less stressful for them.

- We now have \$19k; made \$212 in May book sale.
- Talked about supporting adult programming, have usually focused on children's.
- Membership? NC: Kristofer is chair, got us Square reader for book sales. Star, always doing something. Dempseys. Vicki and Nancy. 3-4 other people who sometimes come.
- 6:57 Discussion: Review and approve Library Building Program for submission to MPLCP
 - We are at the lowest end of "medium" size, 15k sq ft and we're asking for 17k. We're not competing
 against Orange, who's not applying after all. Also applying: Easthampton, a Springfield branch (small). 27
 applicants counting all three lib sizes; not many our size. Arlington (large), Carlisle (maybe around our
 size? maybe smaller?). Some libs just adding a children's room.
 - TP: surprised the three costs came out so close. CK: b/c doesn't take into consideration what it would cost to do asbestos abatement, blast into ledge.
 - WQ: does Carnegie-expansion cost option include purchasing green house? Yes. Zillow estimated \$261k. Not interested in the eminent-domain path if they don't want to sell. CK: wouldn't reach out to them until we are funded.

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- WQ: how many \$million is nostalgia worth? MV: new owners of Carnegie space would remove the nostalgia idea and reinstate Carnegie as museum, concert space, whatever. WQ: my dream is to make it the historical/Nolumbeka bldg. NC: not realistic unless there's \$\$.
- NC: town very sensitive about bldgs remaining unoccupied. TP: could make 2, maybe 3 really nice condos.
 what about the folks who redid the Montague Center school? MV: remember going to some of those
 mtgs (for MC school), my main concern was traffic—and now i barely see anyone.
- Doc unanimously approved for submission!
- Town meeting vote needs 2/3 approval, public referendum needs 1/2. Would be spring of 2026, maybe?
- Next step: RFP for architects, choose an architect. CK: we reach out to folks we think are cool, ask them to apply. TP: believe it's correct that we don't need to choose lowest bidder. the contractor will be low-bid.
 CK: need them to be amenable to matching character of downtown TF. MV: wouldn't be called Carnegie Lib anymore. LI: Great Falls lib.
