#### **Director's Report:**

- Ryan Paxton ("Paxton"), Health Director, presented the March 2025 Director's Report.
  - o 286 Montague City Rd has stalled, and Paxton is not sure it will go any further.
  - o 9 M St has hoarding issues and is currently in housing court.
  - o 3 tobacco fines have been issued for Scotty's on the Hill, Nouria Energy and Cumberland Farms that have not been paid. The appeal deadline has passed. Tobacco Permits will be renewed by July 1, 2025 and they will not be able to renew their tobacco permits without paying the fine. Paxton will mail demand letters.
  - o BOH Chair, Ames-Zamojski asks if there is any update on the housing situation at the Millers Falls Rod & Gun Club, Paxton has no updates.

  - The Board and Paxton discussed, and the Board agreed to waiving fees for all future farmer's markets and to amend the fee schedule to indicate no fee charged for farmer's market vendors.

## Unanticipated Discussion: 62 E Chestnut Hill Rd:

- Work has not been completed but a good faith effort has been made. Smoke detectors and carbon monoxide detectors have been installed since the hearing held on April 9, 2025.
- The property owner states they are having issues getting contractors into the property to do repairs as they are not able to coordinate with the occupant.
- Paxton received communication from the property owner stating she offered monetary compensation for the occupant to move out of the property and the property owners wish to have the property condemned.
- The board will have another hearing on May 1, 2025. Paxton will send out hearing notices to the property owner and the occupant.
