## 1. Please describe and provide the rationale for any substantial changes in your FY20 line item budget submission.

The major increase in this budget is due to a 3% increase from Republic Services, the Town's curbside hauler, and an increase from \$64 per ton to \$85 per ton, a \$21 dollar increase from McNamara Transfer Station, which represents having to stop bringing curbside trash to the Chicopee landfill and shipping it to South Carolina.

A separate document provided by Republic Services shows current pricing from other transfer station operators at the mid \$70's per ton for contracts signed in 2017 and low to mid \$80's for 2018 contracts.

At Steve Ellis's request I contacted K&W of Agawam and was given a verbal quote of \$90 dollars per ton. Note that Republic Services would have to charge an extra fee to transport to K&W in Agawam if that option was chosen. Given this information it was decided to keep everything with Republic Services as reflected above.

There is a new line item labeled Tipping Fees. This was previously included in the Solid Waste Removal line and is now broken out for better accountability.
