Town Administrator Report

Award Unity Park Phase 2 Improvement Project

The project includes improving two existing softball fields, resurfacing and painting existing basketball court, a new asphalt permanent walkway with exercise stations, new park benches, new 33 space asphalt parking area, new rain garden, and a butterfly garden in accordance with the document provided by Berkshire Design Group dated February 27, 2013. We have received 8 bids which range from \$400,060 to as high as \$750,000. There are also alternative bids but Mr. Abbondanzio is recommending that the board accept the base bid from Diversified Construction of \$400,060. Diversified Construction is deemed to be the lowest responsible and eligible bidder.

Mr. Dobosz said the most prominent element of the project is going to reseeding and leveling the ball fields, the fitness path will go around the ball field. He is really excited about all elements and getting the project going.

Mr. Hunter noted that Unity Park building, parking lot, and walkway will be handicapped accessible upon completion of Phase 2.

Mr. Hunter explained that the rain garden is a planted area with a foot of soil where the water will come in and saturate the soil before it discharges, and then go through a cleansing process which will take some of the contaminants before it is discharged. It won't really hold water as a retention area would.

Mr. Fairbrother moved that the board award the contract for the Unity Park Phase 2 Improvement Project to Diversified Construction Services, LLC for the base bid only and for a contract cost of \$400,060. Mr. Boutwell seconded. Approved unanimously. Fairbrother – Aye, Boutwell – Aye, Allen -absent

Mr. Fairbrother further moved to have the Chair sign the contract. Seconded by Mr. Boutwell. Approved unanimously. Fairbrother – Aye, Boutwell – Aye, Allen - Absent

The Board of Selectmen is invited to participate in the Spring Parade on April 20, 2013. The parade is a 3-mile route beginning and ending at Sheffield School.

Registration for Assembly, Public Demonstration, or Use of Public Property

For the Opening Day Parade of the 2013 Youth Baseball season on April 28, 2013. The route is Turnpike Road, Montague Street and ending at the field. It will begin at 11:00 AM and end at approximately 12:00 PM. There are 120 participants expected. The Police Chief has approved the application.

Mr. Fairbrother moved that the board issue two permits, one for the use of public property mainly Turnpike Road and Montague Street and one for public demonstration for the Newt Guilbeault Opening Day Parade on April 28, 2013. Mr. Boutwell seconded. Approved unanimously. Fairbrother – Aye, Boutwell – Aye, Allen - absent

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Relay for Life Tollbooth Annual Fundraiser on April 20, 2013. There will be 4-8 tolltakers. The Police Chief signed the application but asked that they not obstruct traffic.

Mr. Fairbrother moved that the board issue a permit for use of public property, namely the corner/intersection of Avenue and 3rd Street to the Relay for Life Tammy Murphy the contact, for April 20, 2013 from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM.
