## Resolution of the Board of Selectmen regarding the certification of the Millers Falls Village Center as an area of disrepair and disinvestment

Ramsey: Slum and Blight Studies have been done for both Millers Falls Village Center and the Turners Falls Historic Industrial District. These Studies are separate documents but were done concurrently. The studies were subbed out to the FRCOG Planning Department who conducted the site visits, evaluated the infrastructure and compiled the inventory. Two public forums were held for each of these project areas one at the outset and one at the final presentation that were held last week. According to the inventory, both areas in the Town meet Mass. Dept. of Housings definition of blight under Mass. General Law 121B. Slum and Blight designation will allow the town to focus and prioritize its remediation efforts regarding deteriorated properties and poor public infrastructure in these areas under the National Preventive of Prevention or Elimination of Slum and Blight. This designation will also allow the Town further blight by addressing marginal properties that, if left untouched, could deteriorate further. In a nutshell what this designation really means is it gives the town an edge in competing for federal community development money to be targeted for these specific areas because of the demonstrated needs. The designation is valid for 10 years and the end goal is to remove blighted conditions in these two areas. Improvement to blighted areas will bolster property values, decrease turnovers, eliminate environmental hazards that affect the health and safety of the Town's residents, stimulate business growth, and encourage the use of vacant properties.
