In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Town of Montague qualified to vote in Town affairs to meet in the Turners Falls High School Theater on Wednesday, February 11, 2015 at 6:30 P.M. and to act on the following articles and any motions which may be presented.

ARTICLE 1. To see if the town will vote to raise and appropriate, transfer from available funds, borrow or otherwise provide the sum of \$10,078, or any other amount, for the purpose of supplementing Article #9 of the September 12, 2013 Special Town Meeting, which funded costs associated with the implementation of a collective bargaining agreement with the United Electrical, Radio and Machine Workers of America, Local 274 for Fiscal Year 2014, with increases to be paid retroactively to July 1, 2013, or to pass any vote or votes in relation thereto.
