Tina Cote and Michael Perreault, FRTA FY19 Budget Cuts and Possible Route Changes

Discussion:

- The FRTA Advisory Board met on March 15 and discussed making necessary cuts based on what the Governor has projected.
- The Board would like to hold public meetings; tentative dates include April 19th from 6-7:30 and April 24th from 3-4:30.
- They will look at increasing fares, having the buses back by 7:00 PM, and reformulating routes with low ridership.
- Singleton: It's imperative we have a conversation to figure out what Montague's priorities are. I don't support Route 22. I'd like to have more discussion about Route 23.
- Tegal brought attention to the fact that a lot of people will need transportation to the Housing Authority to pay rent and do yearly updates of paper work. These people include mothers with small children and elderly and disabled people who will need a shelter, curb cuts, platform, and/or a safe walkway at the boarding location. Ramsey replied that with the two new developments in that area, the Planning Board will be looking closely at that issue. As the Town is engaged in the Complete Streets Program, we will find a way to make a safe crossing there.

Discussion of Planter Coordinator Vacancy
