- o Money-wise, RiverCulture is in good shape, with old and new sponsors.
- o LoManto states that she encouraged the Brick House to apply for the Mass Cultural Council Youth Reach Grant which, if received, would award \$15,000 for three years (\$45,000).
- LoManto represented Montague by speaking at the Downtown Summit Conference sponsored by the Mass Department of Housing and Community Development.
