- 1. Take roll call
 - a. Present: Annabel Levine, Judith Lorei, Jeri Moran
 - i. Guests: Jamie Fuller
- 2. Approve meeting minutes
 - a. 2/22/22 Minutes Approved Unanimously
- 3. Update: Vote on Articles for Special Town Meeting
 - a. Both articles passed unanimously, the Montague Cemetery Commission (MCC) can now access \$10,000 for repairs.
- 4. Update: Burnham Cemetery
 - a. Wall Repair
 - i. Work starts tomorrow (3/30) at 8AM with Fairview Landscaping taking care of the trees.
 - b. May Burial
 - i. There will be a burial on May 14th.
 - ii. MCC will need to prepare grave for cremains.
 - iii. We will all meet there to prepare the space.
 - iv. MCC will decide on and purchase seed mixes to put down after burial (clover?).
- 5. Update: Highland
 - a. Iron Archway:
 - i. Jeri checked in with the Franklin County Tech School, who want to start working on the archway.
 - ii. Jeri will call Barbara to ask for the quote from the insurance company. Jeri will then reach back out to FCTS and then Partridge-Zschau.
 - b. How to handle burials:
 - MCC discussed extra items we may need to have on hand once burials begin like tables, covers for the grave, etc.
 - c. Green Burial Wooded Section:
 - i. Judith met Jeremiah from Fairview Landscaping at the wooded section.

- 1. Our budget is enough for one day's work, which would be enough to establish phase one.
- 2. Work needs to be completed by the end of June.
 - a. We may need to supplement the one-day fee with some of the cemetery repair fund due to rising costs as the quote is over a year old.
- 3. Candace Currie from Green Burial MA is coming out to do a walkthrough with the MCC at Highland on Friday, 4/8/22 at 3PM.
- d. A section of the back road has collapsed.
 - i. Fairview Landscaping might be able to fix it (fill it). We could use part of cemetery repair fund for that, the committee will wait for a quote.
 - ii. Judith will go out there to mark off the spot.

6. Discussion:

- a. Revised cemetery rules and regulations
 - i. Judith requests comments and edits to be sent to her within the week. Then she'll pass it over to the former Highland Cemetery board for feedback.
- b. Judith will be the point person for contact over Highland, but committee members will rotate taking care of the rest.
- c. Highland inventory spreadsheet
 - i. Annie will put in all lot #s in excel, then work on whether each lot is empty and/or sold.

7. Other Business

- a. Town Tree Grant Trees in Cemeteries
 - i. Tree Committee has grant for free trees, and they were cleared to put them in cemeteries as long as they are visible from the road. Highland could take a few dozen.
 - ii. Annie will talk to Owen Wormser from Local Harmony about recommendations for tree placement.
