## 1. Please describe and provide the rationale for any substantial changes in your FY21 line item budget submission.

The total budget proposed for Legal Counsel is 8% below that for FY20. This change reflects substantial completion of union contract renewals, which were ongoing during a 12 month period during FY19 and FY20. Accordingly, the personnel and labor relations line is where the reductions are located.

It is the Town Administrator's opinion that shifting from the incumbent Sullivan Hayes and Quinn Associates to KP Law for personnel related matters has resulted in more responsive labor counsel guidance at a lower overall cost to the Town and the present arrangement of using KP for both general and labor counsel will continue in FY21.
