	The Town Clerk's office will have 3 Elections this Fiscal Year, including a huge Presidential Election in November which will also include 11 days of Early Voting in town hall. The Secretary of State's office is predicting an unprecedented turnout for the Presidential election.
	I will not be able to have a level funded budget for FY 21 due to the huge election year. My budget is cyclical – it depends on the amount of elections each year. Currently FY 22 has only one scheduled Election; therefore my budget will be significantly lower.
2.	Did you receive funding for any special articles in FY20? What is the status of those expenditures/investments?
	Yes, I did receive \$50,000 in funding for Optical Scanners. I bought 4 optical scanners and 3 ballot boxes with election accessories and an election reporting package for a total of 28,694. The 4 th optical scanner is a back-up for any possible Election Day malfunction – the state highly recommends all clerks have a back-up in their arsenal.
	I also have rented three additional optical scanners with ballot boxes for a total of \$5,175 for a year. I have hopes of reducing the town's precincts from 6 to only 3. Precincts are designated by MGL and by population. Montague only needs 3 precincts. My hope is to have them reduced at the May 2021 Annual Town Meeting.
	If the precinct reduction is approved and passed at town meeting, I am all set with the amount of machines I have currently purchased. If not approved, I will need to purchase 3 more complete bundles.
	Currently there is a balance of \$16,131 in the special article.
