- 1. Please describe and provide the rationale for any substantial changes in your FY21 line item budget submission. We added additional funds for electricity and oil for the new DPW building. The only other substantial increases were contractual wage increases.
- 2. Did you receive funding for any special articles in FY20? What is the status of those expenditures/investments?

Yes, we received \$240,000 towards the purchase of new Elgin Street Sweeper, with the remaining \$25,000 coming from our discretionary account.

3. Did you receive funding for a discretionary account in FY20? What have you purchased to date, at what cost? Looking forward in FY21, what do you expect to purchase at what cost?

We've made the following purchases from the Discretionary Accounts in FY20: \$9,215 on a Superline Trailer to move the Mini Excavator, \$13,787 on several tools/equipment for the garage and \$1,888 for a major vehicle repair. We also used \$25,000 towards the new Elgin Sweeper. In the future I would like to replace a 2006 Dodge Dakota pick up truck for the custodian and we are also going to have to replace a motor on one of our 6 wheeled dump trucks, which will cost about \$15,000.

4. To-date in FY20, has your department experienced any notable successes, such as improving or providing new programs or services, or implementing new technologies? If so, please describe.

The crew had a very busy season; two of the bigger projects were adding drain lines on Crocker Ave to elevate a large standing water issue there and adding two bump outs in Montague Center to reduce speed though the town.

5. Are there challenges to your department's ability to meet its goals and objectives that are due to its FY20 operating budget? If so, offer your recommendation(s) for improving the situation.

All goals are being met financially. There is a possible need for two more grounds personnel who would help do much needed tree trimming.
