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An old graveyard can tell quite a story.

There is the poignancy of Cephas and Mary Root, who lost 4 little children in a 7 year span and were left childless - yet still hopeful. For the inscription on the gravestone (No. 278) of the last child to die (in 1826), relates:

"He has left us to mourn/And gone to his rest/With brothers and sisters/  
We hope to be blest/The parting was sad/Not in words to be told/His life was more precious/Than silver and gold."

There is the tragic lament on the stone of Capt. Moses Harvey (No. 132), who also died in the same period (1795 at age 72), so the inscription had to have been placed on it by his wife: (The sons are buried with him.)

"All these, my four sons, died in 3 months and 2 days. Not any of my family left, except my wife and one daughter to lament the loss."

The gravestone (No. 275) of Phineas Hosmer tells us that he drowned in the Connecticut River at the age of 19; and that his friend, Samuel Marsh, Jr., having reached safety, went back to help, and also drowned.

Then - what is probably the best known stone in the entire cemetery (No. 107) - relates this sad tale:

"In Memory of Mr. Elijah Bordwell who died Jan<sup>y</sup> 26th, 1786 in ye 27th year of his age, having but a few days survived ye fatal night when he was flung from his horse and drawn by ye stirrup 26 rods along ye path, as appear'd by ye place where his hat was found, and where he had spent ye whole following severe cold night treading ye snow in a small circle. The family he left was an aged Father, a Wife and 3 small children."

These are the human interest stories; the ones that tug at your heart. But there are other things an old graveyard can tell us about life and death in early times; a little about the causes of death; and a great deal about longevity.

There were 471 stones in Old South as of May, 1975, which recorded the deaths of 499 people. They spanned a period from 1759 to 1974; with the greatest use of the cemetery being between 1800 and 1860. Prior to 1800 there are not enough stones left to be considered representative; and after 1860 burials fell off rapidly as other cemeteries became more popular. So not many younger people were buried in Old South after 1860; its use being mainly by older people being laid to rest with family members already buried there.

So it is the 1800 to 1860 period that has been analyzed as most representative; with the silent testimony of the cemetery telling us of the high infant and children's death rate; of the young women who died in their child-bearing years. It also tells us of those who got past the high risk years, and went on to live well into their 80's and 90's. It was a time when the strong survived and the weak died young - and in sufficient quantities to pull the entire life span down to about 40 years of age; even tho nearly 25% of the people lived past the three score and ten mark, to average 81.1 years of age.

There was an average of 5.4 deaths per year over the 60 year period, amongst a population that averaged \*1,250 people, during the same period.

During the period 1810 to 1820 someone at the Congregational Church kept a partial record of causes of death, and out of 55 burials in Old South during that decade, there were 32 causes found - enough to give a fairly good picture as to what 'carried them off'. These were:

8 who d. of consumption; 4 of typhus; 3 of fever; 3 of apoplexy; 2 in an epidemic; 2 of old age; and 1 each of numb palsy; palsy; scrofula; lingering illness; lethargy; pleurisy; cancer; palpitating of heart; palpitations (a young lady of 17); and dropsy (a young woman of 25).

There was also one death probably resulting from childbirth, as Mrs. Mary L. Gunn (No. 374) who died 4/16/1810, age 17, had given birth to a son on 4/1/1810; but the records consistently maintained a discreet silence on this subject.

The Church records gave no death causes in the period 1820 to 1840, except for 1 of fever, but tombstone inscriptions show that 1 died of drowning; 1 of "hooping" cough; and 1 probable childbirth - that of Ann Esterbrook, (No. 287) who died in 1825, age 27. "Farewell my dear partner/I bid you adieu/And dear tender offspring/Farewell unto you/..."

Between 1840 and 1850 the Church again recorded some death causes, and out of 62 burials during the decade, 18 causes were found:

8 of consumption; 6 of old age; and 1 each of cancer; fever; typhus; and cholera.

Consumption was by far the leading destroyer of life, with most of its victims under the age of 20. Typhus came next, with old age not far behind. It is interesting to note that, outside of 2 cases of 'palpitations', heart disease did not seem to be much of a problem; nor did cancer, at least on the basis of the records as given.

In order to arrive at the figures used, it was necessary to arrange the deaths in the cemetery in chronological order, and this listing is given beginning on page 43. This chronology was further broken down into 6 different time periods, which will be given here for anyone interested in probing the statistics of Old South.

For the period 1759 to 1800, by age groups:

There was an average of 1.6 deaths per year over the 40 year period, amongst a population that averaged 840 people during the period, as based on the census figures available. This low number indicates that many of the early gravestones are missing.

The available census shows a population of 392 people in 1765; 906 in 1790; and 1,222 in 1800.

There was an average of 4.4 deaths per year over the 20 year period, amongst a population that averaged 1,077 people.

The census shows a population of 1,222 in 1800; 934 in 1810; and 1,074 in 1820.

There was an average of 6.9 deaths per year over the 20 year period, amongst a population that averaged 1,160 people.

The census shows a population of 1,074 in 1820; 1,152 in 1830; and 1,255 in 1840.

For the period 1840 to 1860, by age groups:

There was an average of 4.95 deaths per year over the 20 year period, amongst a population that averaged 1,455 people. This period is beginning to reflect the trend away from burial in Old South by the younger segment of the population.

The census shows a population of 1,255 in 1840; 1,518 in 1850; and 1,593 in 1860.

There was an average of 2.0 burials per year over the 40 year period; amongst a population that averaged 4,228 people. This period shows the mass exodus to other cemeteries by the younger age groups.

The census shows a population of 1,593 in 1860; 2,224 in 1870; 4,875 in 1880; 6,296 in 1890; and 6,150 in 1900. So the population is about 3-1/2 times greater in this period, than it was in the 1800 to 1860 period, but the burials are 4 times less. (Average pop. 1800 - 1860 was 1,250, compared to 4,228 in 1860 to 1900. Burials 1800 - 1860 were 323, compared to 79, 1860 - 1900.)

There was an average of less than 1 burial every 2 yrs. in this 74 year period. I do not have population figures for after the year 1930, but in 1930 it was 8,081 people.

Our average life span today is much longer than it was in the 1759 to 1800 period, when it averaged 34.5 yrs., as compared to about 70 yrs. now; but it has been pulled up by considerably extending the life expectancy of the under 20 age group, whereas the average age at death in the over 70 age group is actually reduced - if burials in Old South cemetery is used as a yardstick. Viz:

These gravestone readings were made on May 20, 21, & 22, 1975; the inscriptions being read into a tape recorder and later transcribed to typescript. There were 471 stones (most of them with footstones) found in the cemetery; and this includes standing, fallen, and broken stones. Anything that was readable was taped. Many were so badly weathered that much cleaning and/or rubbing was required to bring out the data, and even then some of it was questionable. A weathered 4 looks like a 1; the numbers 3, 5, & 8 are easily confused, one for the other; but considering that many of the markers are 150 to 200 years old, their general condition is remarkable.

The oldest stone found, of which we were sure of the date, was No. 70 - that of Elijah Root who died Oct. 26, 1759, age 3 y. & 9 m. However, there is a footstone (No. 129), bearing only the initials, either "S. C." or "S. G." and a date of either 1753 or 1853. If this date should prove to be 1753, then it is the oldest stone in the cemetery. It stands near markers of the Clapp family, adding weight to the initials being "S. C."; however the earliest Clapp death found was that of Polly (No. 186) who d. in 1785; the earliest Clapp birth recorded was that of Parsons, son of Daniel & Abigail, born July 26, 1772; and the earliest Clapp marriage found was an intent dated Aug. 1, 1765 between Mehitabel Clap(sic) and Benjamin Alvord, both of Montague - thus suggesting that the Clapp family may not have lived in Montague as early as 1753.

The latest stone found was that of Howard "Lee" Zentgraf (No. 187), who died in 1974; however there were very few burials in the cemetery after 1900.

As much as possible the readings were done in rows, in order to keep families together (buried side by side), but in many cases a large family occupied a lot that was 2 or even 3 rows deep. However, in such cases, we still followed the side by side, row by row method, as this was the most efficient way to do it and helped to avoid the possibility of skipping someone. So a family might begin in row #1, with the remainder in row #2 or #3, and still all be on the same lot.

Unfortunately the cemetery is not laid out in neat, straight rows, so our row numbering system is, at best, a matter of personal opinion. We began at the far left-hand front corner (as you face the gate) and proceeded to the right with row #1. However this row angled and ran out before reaching the front gate, so the first row inside the gate is actually our row #2 - which we began at the right end, and worked toward the left.

It will be noted that spelling of the same family name might vary from stone to stone, even on the same lot. This was not unusual in early days when uniform spelling of a name was often the exception, rather than the rule.

There is a section of the cemetery - to the far left, and to the rear as you face the front gate - in which very few stones were found; and those that were there, bore the earliest dates. We suspected there were many early burials in that area, but that the stones are no longer in existence.

The Montague Vital Records, published by the Essex Institute, Salem, Mass. somewhere between 1939 & 1945, took some of its data from gravestone readings in Old South cemetery; although the list of gravestones given in the MVR is far from a complete listing of stones in the cemetery. It does, however, give us some basis of comparison of those found there 30 or 40 years ago, as compared with those found in 1975 - and there were only four (4) listed then, that were not found in 1975. These were:

1. Ebenezer Bangs, died Dec. \_\_\_\_\_.

(And apparently the stone was either broken at that time, or the rest of it unreadable. M.C.)

- 2. Experience Bardwell, dau. of Moses Bardwell, died Dec. 3, 1814, age 24 yrs. (of consumption - CCR)
- 3. Quartus, son of Elihu and Eunice Clapp, \_\_\_\_\_. (This is prob. No. 183) (This was all that could be read at that time. The MVR gives the birth of Quortus Clapp, son of Elihu & Eunice, on Nov. 15, 1785.)
- 4. Deacon Elijah Root, died Aug. 6, 1812, age 75.

There were probably many more stones that disappeared in the years between the 1930's and 1975, but as stated before, the MVR of deaths from Old South gravestone readings is far from complete; most having been taken from the Town records, private records, or the Congregational Church records. There are deaths given of parents and some of their children - and all buried in Old South. But other children of the same parents, who died about the same time, were not found in the cemetery, yet were probably buried there and their tombstones gone.

After most of the inscriptions there is such further identification of the person as could be found in the following references: (The initials preceding the reference will be used throughout the typescript to identify the source of the data given.)

This may be the Abner of the footstone, except it seems unusual to give the title of 'Mr.' to a child.)  
  
In front of #6 is a stone broken off and unreadable. Perhaps the headstone of Mr. Abner Root.
7. This marble marks the grave of Mrs. Caroline, wife of Mr. Jonathan Root, who died 22 April 1823, ae 65. Footstone: C.R.  
(Mrs. Caroline Wells, 2nd. wife of Jonathan Root - MVR)
8. Sacred to the Memory of Mrs. Sybil, consort of Mr. Edward Ruggles. She died April 10...(rest of stone below ground & cannot be read.)  
Footstone: Mrs. Sybil Ruggles  
(MVR gives her d. date as April 10, 1802. CCR gives her ae at death as 45 yrs.)
9. Mr. Elijah Root died Mar. 31st, 1852, ae 87 yrs. Footstone: E.R.
