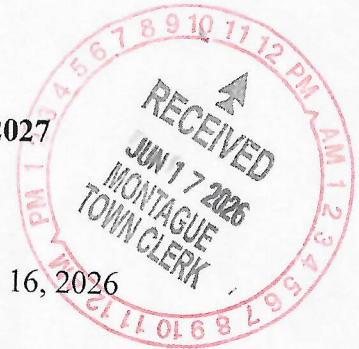

WARRANT FOR ANNUAL MEETING - FISCAL YEAR 2026-2027

To: Christall Cutler, Clerk of the Montague Center Fire District

Greetings:

In the name of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, you are hereby directed to notify and warn the Inhabitants of the Montague Center Fire District who are qualified to vote in the District Meetings to meet at the Montague Center Fire Station, 28 Old Sunderland Road, Montague, MA, on **THURSDAY, THE TWENTY-FIFTH DAY OF JUNE, 2026** at 7:00 o'clock in the evening, then and there to vote on the following articles:

ARTICLE 1: To choose a Moderator to preside at said Annual Meeting.

ARTICLE 2: To choose all necessary officers of the District, viz; Clerk and Treasurer, each to serve for a term of one (1) year; one (1) member of the Prudential Committee for a term of three years; one (1) member of the Prudential Committee for a term of two years (to fill an unexpired term).

ARTICLE 3: To hear the reports of all District Officers, or act anything thereon.

ARTICLE 4: To see if the District will authorize the Treasurer to borrow a sum or sums of money from time to time in anticipation of revenue, or act thereon.

ARTICLE 5: To see if the District will vote to raise by taxation and appropriate, or to pay from available funds in the treasury, or otherwise provide, any sum or sums of money for the maintenance and repair, operation and the incidental expenses of the District, including but not limited to those hereinafter set forth, or act anything thereon:

Fire Station Maintenance	Debt and Indebtedness
Fire Apparatus & Maintenance	Treasurer's Bond and Expense
Fire Department & Maintenance	Miscellaneous Supplies
Insurance	District Salaries

ARTICLE 6: To see if the District will vote to raise by taxation and appropriate, or to pay from available funds in the Treasury, any sum or sums of money for the purpose of the services and expenses of the Collector of the District and the services and expenses of the Assessor or Assessors of the District, or act anything thereon.

ARTICLE 7: To see if the District will vote to raise by taxation and appropriate, or to pay from available funds in the Treasury, or otherwise provide, any sum or sums of money for the purpose of purchasing fire hose and other equipment for the Fire Department or act anything thereon.

ARTICLE 8: To see if the District will vote to raise by taxation and appropriate, or to pay from available funds in the Treasury, or otherwise provide, any sum or sums of money for the purpose of firefighter/EMT

training, or act anything thereon.

ARTICLE 9: To see if the District will vote to raise by taxation and appropriate, or to pay from available funds in the Treasury, or otherwise provide, any sum or sums of money for the purpose of purchasing water source supplies and expenses, or act anything thereon.

ARTICLE 10: To see if the District will vote to raise by taxation and appropriate, or to pay from available funds in the Treasury, or otherwise provide, any sum or sums of money for the purpose of purchasing firefighter safety equipment, or act anything thereon.


ARTICLE 11: To see if the District will vote to raise by taxation and appropriate, or to pay from available funds in the Treasury, or otherwise provide, any sum or sums of money to be paid into or deposited in the District's Stabilization fund in accordance with the provisions of the Massachusetts General Laws, as amended, and in particular Chapter 40 thereof, or act anything thereon.

ARTICLE 12: To see if the District will vote to authorize the Prudential Committee, on behalf of the District and subject to the requirements of Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 30B or any other Massachusetts General Laws, to (a) purchase one US Fire Apparatus Commercial Tanker with a heavy duty extruded aluminum body, mounted upon a two-door Freightliner M2-106+ cab and chassis with 1,500 GPM Hale QMax Pump and 3,000 gallon water tank and various related firefighting appliances, hose and safety equipment, for an amount not to exceed \$600,000 and (b) to authorize the Prudential Committee, upon such terms as they deem necessary or advisable, to take any and all actions necessary to effectuate the purposes of the foregoing vote, said funds to be taken from a combination of the stabilization fund, free cash and/or borrowing, or take any action relative thereto or thereon.


AND you are directed to serve this Warrant by posting an attested copy thereof in two or more public places in the District at least seven (7) days before said Annual Meeting.

HEREOF FAIL NOT and make a return of this Warrant with your doings thereon at the time and place of said Meeting.


