- e. Farren property now belongs to the Town; Planning Dept will be in charge; will a Montague City Historic District be considered? CC notes that he doubts that our participation in decision-making will be requested.

- g. 42 Canal Street: owner inquires about DOT plan to construct new bridge; owner is unsure how his property will be impacted.
- h. Former St. Anne's Church: ATT+T will want to modify the steeple. Just FYI notice; modifications should not alter the exterior.
- i. On-going discussions and planning for a Montague Historic Preservation Plan and eventual grant: HC should submit a letter of interest by November; process will involve a matching grant that the Town meeting would have to vote on this. We will need to coordinate with Town Planner and FRCOG
- j. Archaeological field work done in Cabot Woods. Report available on request.
